	Before the Move - Preparation Stage	<b>~</b>

	PRO MOVING TIP: Smart Box Labelling Hack (Credit: Alvin Poh)	<b>~</b>
1	Number Your Boxes Clearly – Instead of writing long lists on masking tape, just write 'Box 1, Box 2' in bold numbers.	
2	Keep a Master List in Your Phone – Use your notepad app to record what's inside each box (e.g., Box 1: Microphone, desk mat, mouse; Box 2: Extension cords, multi-plugs, spare cables).	
3	Search on the Go – Can't find your cables? Just type 'cables' into your phone, and you'll know exactly which box to open.	

	On Moving Day – Stay Organised	<b>~</b>
1	Pack Essentials Separately – Keep a bag with daily-use items like toiletries, chargers, clothes, and important documents.	
2	Double-Check Fragile Wrapping – Glassware, electronics, and décor should be properly cushioned.	
3	Oversee Dismantling & Loading – Watch as movers dismantle and wrap furniture before loading.	
4	Check Inventory – Track your boxes as they're loaded into the lorry.	
5	Secure Access Routes – Make sure lifts and loading bays are available during the scheduled time.	
6	Communicate with Movers – Stay in touch with your assigned project manager throughout the process.

3	Reassemble & Set Up – Movers should reassemble major furniture like beds and wardrobes.	
4	Unpack Essentials First – Start with kitchenware, toiletries, and daily-use items.	
5	Arrange Disposal if Needed – Some movers provide post-move disposal services for old or unwanted items.	
6	Check Utilities & Internet – Ensure water, electricity, and Wi-Fi are active before moving day.

5	Confirm parking/loading restrictions if you're moving in CBD or high-traffic areas.	
6	For blankets, soft toys, and pillows that don't fit well into boxes, movers can wrap them securely in stretch film for clean and easy transport.
